Commissioner Green said everyone is out enjoying the weather.

There was a public comment from someone with the sailing program who said Molly and herself had a good visit with Eugene on the phone a few days ago. She visited with the engineers on the docks to get an update about what's going on. She wonders about what John has to say tonight.

There was another public comment. He mentioned the dock boxes and how there are a number of dock boxes. He suggested the Port Manager come up with standard fiberglass dock box. He described the process about obtaining uniform dock boxes.

Old Business

Breakwater Updates

Mr. Piccone said things are starting to look a lot like a breakwater. Floats are assembled and in place, including ones on the angled corner. The pilings have been cut and capped. The electricians have been working hard on their end. The fire suppression system and potable water system are both 90% completed. Looking over the next month or so, he expects

electricians to be finished with the main feeder work that goes from the Anderson parking lot to AA Dock. They'll be finishing up the remainder of the wire poles and other accessories on the breakwater itself. By the end of next week, the fire and water system will be as complete as possible until we get AA connector float. There is no firm date on delivery for that yet, but he expects it in the next two to three weeks. All the pilings are done and complete. Just a matter of getting the hoops put in. the utility connections can happen that that point.

The 50' finger piers are the ones that'll be built and installed first, followed by 30' finger piers. He will keep everyone posted on the updates for delivery dates. Over the next month safety equipment, fire extinguishers, ladders, etc. are expected to arrive.

The E&F Dock preliminary grant score has been tallied and published. Poulsbo scored well and will be within range to receive the full funding that was requested (which was \$548,000). Awards come out in June. Mr. Piccone's schedule is to carry on with design and finish the corps permitting. He is still working on the original schedule plan for the 2023-2024 fish window.

X Dock and the various access improvements have gate requests sent out. They're due back to him by tomorrow. All indications point to gates falling within approved budgets. He will select a vendor and give notice to proceed. He knows the Port would like gates delivered with 90 days after notice to proceed is granted. Mr. Piccone anticipates having a vendor in place next week and will go ahead and start working on quotes on locksmiths to replace the C dock gate, two locks on restrooms, and the new gates.

Dinghy Insurance

Commissioner Singer asked Port Accountant Tripp if someone comes up with their dinghy, does the Port have the words to prepare to say for that type of dinghy with that type of motor does not require insurance, or if it does, what insurance does it require? He wants the standardized ability to make it very clear.

Eugene said this pertains to dinghy storage for permanent moorage who want to store small boats, but 14' or bigger needs insurance just like any other boat. Any verbiage for the bigger boats that come in with their own dingy can be written to clarify. This is what Commissioner Singer wants to be unmistakably clear about.

After brief consideration, the board agreed there is no verbiage to clearly present at this time. The board will work toward having something that is written, reviewed, and presented.
